I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.

Ryan Road Construction Update

As part of the I-94 North-South Project, the reconstruction of the Ryan Road Interchange began in October 2017. A traffic switch, on Ryan Road, is scheduled to take place in early December.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- The Park and Ride lot located at Ryan Road and I-94 was closed December 3 and is anticipated to reopen in fall 2018.
- Double lane closures on Ryan Road, from 27th Street to just east of 13th Street, and a reduction of ramp turn bays are scheduled to begin December 7th eastbound and December 8th westbound to prepare for demolition and construction of the north half of the Ryan Road bridge over I-94. A single lane will remain open for eastbound and westbound Ryan Road traffic. Access to all ramps will be maintained.
- Overnight full freeway closures are scheduled for December 14th and 18th for demolition of the north half of the Ryan Road bridge over I-94 North and South. Traffic will utilize the entrance and exit ramps at Ryan Road as a detour. Ryan Road, over I-94, will remain open during the demolition (with one lane of traffic in each direction).

The project will remain in the static, single lane phase, until mid-fall 2018.
