




Noise Ordinance

Municipal Code Chapter 11.26



Unreasonably loud noise is prohibited.

No one in the City can create or maintain unusually loud noise that is prolonged or unusually loud.

Some of the noises that are restricted between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. by Municipal Code Chapter 11.26 include but are not limited to:

- ◆ loud continuous yelling
- ◆ screaming
- ◆ shouting
- ◆ hooting
- ◆ whistling
- ◆ singing

A noise is considered to be unreasonable if it can be heard within a single or duplex family dwelling from which the noise is not originating or if it is plainly audible 50 feet or more away.


The exception of this provision shall be such events as fairs, carnivals, sporting events, or similar events.



Some other noises not allowed between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. are:

- motor vehicle horns
- racing the engine for more than 15 seconds or at continuous and frequent intervals

- playing of radio, stereo, or musical instrument for long periods of time or at loud volumes
- the use of any musical instrument, loud speakers, sound amplifying equipment or other device to make noise
- allowing animals to make loud or continuous noise
