## PERMIT CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS

This permit governs the temporary encroachment into public right-of-way for the purpose of performing construction on adjacent private property and/or temporary storage of materials related to work on adjacent private property as outlined in Sections 6.27(a)(3), 6.27(d)(12) and 6.27(f)(d) of the Oak Creek Municipal Code. The following shall apply:

- All operations shall be performed without closing any street traffic lane, except as may be specifically allowed under this permit by the City. Unless otherwise authorized, adequate width two-way traffic shall be maintained at all times. Temporary traffic control signage and barricade placement shall be installed and maintained in conformance with the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), at Permittee's expense Such temporary traffic control shall be supplemented by flagmen when the work operations or site distance conditions warrant that the further safety precautions are necessary.
- Length time for valid permit shall be at the discretion of the City Engineer.
- All overhead work shall be protected with supplemental barricading and warning devices. Sidewalk closings shall be properly signed in advance of 3. the work zone to promote pedestrians to cross at ADA crosswalks.
- 4. All refuse, excess dirt, and materials shall be removed from the site and the site restored to original condition as the work progresses or immediately upon its completion.
- Private drives and roadways shall not remain closed overnight, over weekends, or holidays. Before obstructing or closing any private drives or 5. roadways, owner or occupant shall be notified by Permittee.
- Permittée shall at all times perform the work and maintain the site in accordance with all provisions of this permit, and shall assume all liability and 6. responsibility for any and all damage and personal injury resulting from this work.
- A copy of this permit, and related traffic control plan and list of approved work allowed under this permit where applicable, shall be on site while the 7. work is taking place and shall be provided for examination by City enforcement personnel upon request.

  If work is not commenced within 60 days of permit issuance, the permit shall become expired, and a new permit and fee will be required to be obtained.
- Final approval and release from the permit requirements shall not take place until the appropriate City representative grants approval. 9.
